

PARLI PRO MATCHING

(This activity will need to be printed out and cut into pieces.)

To play this game, as people walk into the meeting, hand each one a card. Tell them to keep it until you do the activity before, during, or after the meeting.

When it is time to play, explain that the object of the game is for everyone to find the card that corresponds with their own.

For example: **The correct way to introduce a motion** goes with **I move...**

In order for the activity to run smoothly, you must make sure that for each card you pass out, its pair is also handed out. This will prevent people from not having a match.

Also, try not to pass out matching cards to families, because this is a great way for club members to get to know each other.
